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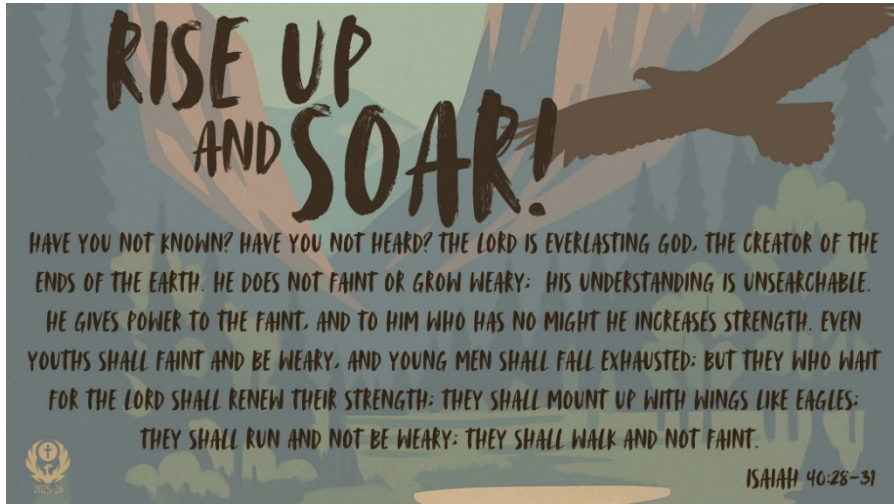

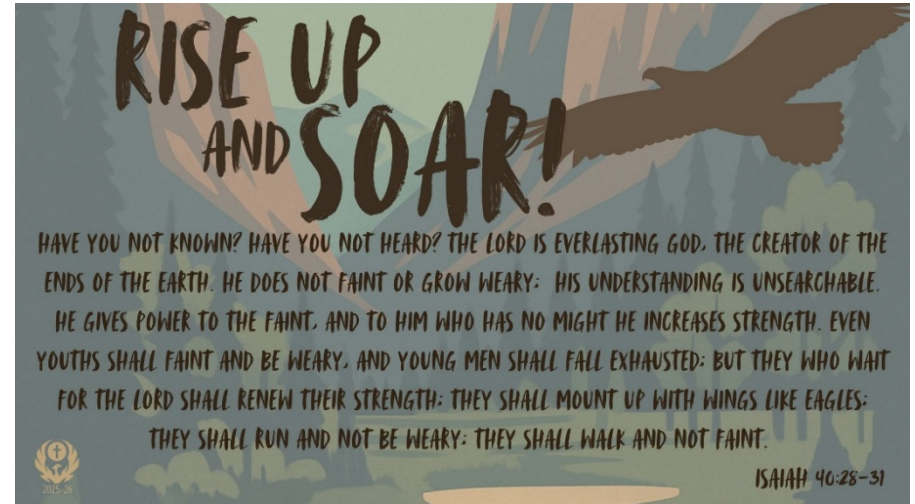
When we trust in the Lord, He renews our strength—like eagles soaring high in the sky.
