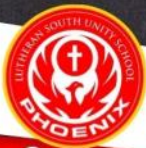

We are excited about the change in our registration/reenrollment process. We will be doing online registration through Fast Direct to help streamline the registration experience for parents, students, and staff. Contact the office if you need any help logging into Fast Direct.

The system is ready to have you register your student for 2024-2025. Before you log in select the word "Registration " on the left hand side. Then answer the prompts. It will then ask you to log in. You may pay the "early bird" registration fee on line or in the office. The forms will be emailed to you to fill in and return.
