Baptism Now Saves!

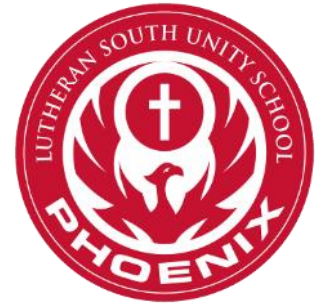

Design and print a keychain! We will go over the basics of 3D printing and take you through the process from digital design to finished printed project.



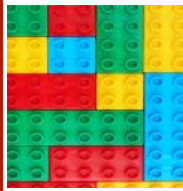
Wednesday, March 13 4:30-5:30PM: Teen Maker Club

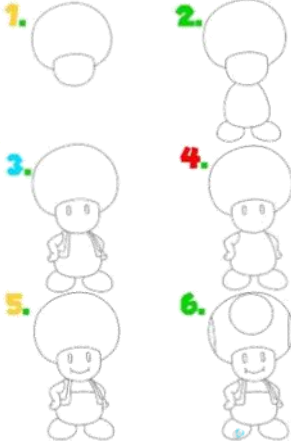
