The Honor Flight's mission is to transport America's Veterans to Washington D.C. to visit those memorials dedicated to honor the service and sacrifices of themselves and their friends.

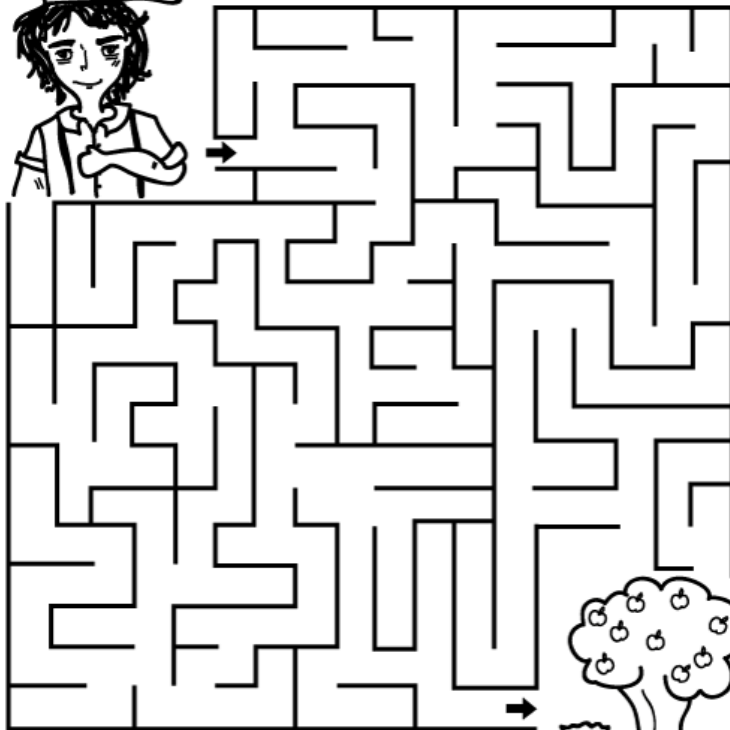
