Thursday, January 8th 3:30-4:30PM: Neurodivergent Teen Hangout: DIY Cube Fidgets **Grade 7th-12th**

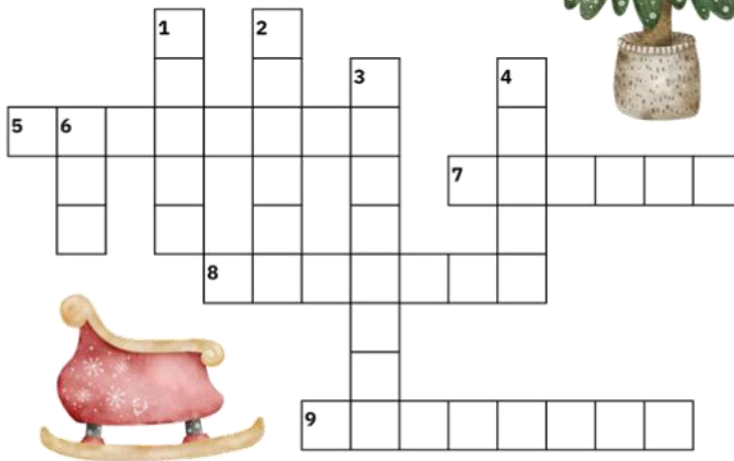
