LSUS Families here are 3 important notes for this week:

Festive Dress Code Day. On Thursday, December 17, we will have a DRESS DOWN dress code day. This is a day where a normal dress code may still apply or if you choose you may dress according to the DRESS DOWN guidelines listed below. We do not want to have any dress code violations which will include being sent to the office to call home for a set of regular dress code clothes to wear for the day. Please understand students not following the dress code will not be able to be in class. It just simply isn't fair to those who followed the guidelines, so choose wisely and if unsure ask your teacher. We do not want to spoil what should be a fun day for kids. If you know what you want to wear and are concerned or wonder about it ask your teacher or check with the office.

Student shirts or tops: Tops or shirts may include a Christmas sweater, sweatshirt, or shirt. They may also wear solid red, white or green shirts. No low cut, sleeveless or strapless tops or shirts may be worn. Areas that are normally covered with their normal dress code shirt need to be covered or they will be in a dress code violation and a call home for a change of clothes.

Pants: Our regular dress code pants will look good with any special Christmas top above. Students may also choose to wear jeans, however, jeans must be without holes and must ride the waist or have a belt to keep them up and not drag on the floor. No sweatpants, no leggings or jeggings.
