Dear Friend of Mercy's Gate,

In 2024, Mercy's Gate embraced the theme "You Will Be Saved," a powerful reminder that everyone, regardless of their circumstances, is cherished and worthy of Christ's love, forgiveness, and tender mercies. This message resonated deeply as we served 16,395 people in our community, providing 38,130 acts of service.

Mercy's Gate makes tangible difference in people's lives

This year, 82% of our expenditures directly supported programs assisting our Neighbors in need. We addressed essential needs through housing assistance for 1,069 people, utility assistance for 1,747 people, food pantry assistance for 14,958 people, and medical assistance for 1,478 people. Our seasonal programs also significantly impacted 4,245 individuals. These numbers reflect the trust placed in us and the tangible difference we make in people's lives. We could not have done this alone. Individuals contributed \$515,480, churches \$218,899, and grants totaled \$238,740.

These numbers tell a story of compassion and community, but they only scratch the surface of changed lives. Time and again, we hear from those we serve about the difference this support has made — whether it's keeping a roof over their heads, ensuring their families have food, or simply providing hope in moments of darkness.
