OVERCOMING OBSTACLES

Shot 3 times. Addicted.

Homeless. Ellis had no selfesteem and felt that no one loved him. His drug addiction had consumed every aspect of his life. Without a proper place to live and friends dying from overdoses, he never knew where his next meal would come. Deep in his addiction, he had lost respect for himself, and his family had lost respect for him, as well.

After the police raided his hotel room and took him into custody, Ellis began to think about what he really wanted out of life. There were so many days and nights wasted locked up in hotel rooms, getting high, and losing hope. He felt that this experience was God's way of speaking to him to get his life back together. Today, two years later, Ellis says "I wish I could thank the police officer that arrested me that day; he saved my life."

Ellis entered The Rescue Mission's long-term program for recovery, but what he found was much more than sobriety. He found people who truly loved and invested in him. He found new confidence in the Lord, and in turn, new confidence in himself.

After much hard work, Ellis graduated from the long-term program. "I will never go back to that. The addiction had me for so many years. If it weren't for the Mission, I know I would be dead." Ellis now has two cars, his own home, and his family and his children's respect back.

Ellis is a shining example of living out the purpose that God has created for him. His journey has come full circle! As a full-time employee at The Rescue Mission, he serves as an example for the current men in programming, guiding, encouraging, and leading them towards change for good. "It's an amazing thing once you turn your life around."

LOST BUT NOW FOUND

Kara had lost herself to drinking, as a way to numb the trauma around her. She was in an abusive relationship with an unfaithful man. Embattled in legal trouble, Kara went to jail and lost custody of her son. She was always looking for her worth - in her family, friends, and relationships. She could never fill the emptiness that she felt. Kara was lost, not knowing who she was as a person. Desperate for a healthier life, she could not escape from the vicious cycle of self-doubt, abuse, and addiction.

Kara made several attempts to stay clean through help from

several halfway houses. When she finally came to Charis House, she knew she was home. "This is where my healing is at." Alcohol had taken so much from her, but it didn't take away her hope.

She knew the importance of her recovery and truly surrendered. "I really dove in and wanted to do this right. My life depended on it." In the last six months of being at The Charis House, she started to find herself again. "It's been a slow unveiling of who I really am." Kara felt more authentic to who God was calling her to be. "I am getting to know myself, and it's exciting, but sometimes scary-but I am so excited. I have hope again; I am worth it."

Kara wishes that donors knew the true impact they make on people's lives. That without donors, none of this life-changing work would be possible. "I wish they knew all the lives they change. Not just the individual; but everyone in that individual's life. All of my relationships are restored. Donors restore hope."
