JANUARY



Sweatpants & Sweatshirts

Sweatpants and sweatshirts/hoodies are especially needed in the cooler months. Sweatshirts sizes XL - 4X. Sweatpants sizes M-XL for men and women

FEBRUARY



Ethnic Hair Products & Men's Razors

Items like hair grease, moisturizer, oil sheen, shampoo/conditioner (for natural hair)

MARCH



Underwear

For men: sizes M - 4X.
For women: sizes 5-9, XL - 4X.
All sizes for children

APRIL



Waterproof Raincoats

Raincoats are extremely needed going into the wet Spring months. Men and women coats of any size are needed.

MAY



Shorts, T-shirts, Flip Flops, Sunscreen

Men's athletic shorts and t-shirts sizes M - 4X. Flip flops M- XL and sunscreen

JUNE



Unscented lotion, body powder, and disinfecting wipes

Unscented lotion, body powder, and disinfecting wipes of any brand or scent.

JULY



Deodorant & Cleaning Wipes

For men: regular and travel
For women: regular size
Containers of cleaning/disinfecting wipes

AUGUST



Winter Coats

Winter coats are always in high demand and hard to find in the winter. Men's, women's, and children's coats in all sizes are needed

SEPTEMBER



Sweatpants & Sweatshirts

Sweatpants and sweatshirts/hoodies are especially needed in the cooler months. Sweatshirts sizes XL - 4X. Sweatpants sizes M-XL for men and women

OCTOBER



Weatherproof Gloves & Handwarmers

With colder weather the need to keep warm becomes very important. All size gloves for men, women, and children & handwarmers

NOVEMBER



Underwear

For men: sizes M - 4X.
For women: sizes 5-9, XL - 4X.
All sizes for children

Diapers & Pull-ups (select sizes)
